

Sunday Rally: Our Sunday event coincides with the 25th anniversary of massive protests at Vandenberg AFB in March of 1983, when over 800 people were arrested resisting the beginning of testing there of the MX (“Peacekeeper”) missile. Please be there as close to noon as possible. Bring signs that are in keeping with the theme of the event, i.e. an end to testing of ICBM’s...25 years is 25 too many...incredible waste of resources... provocative...destabilizing...etc. While an anti-war stance is important, it would be good if we can present a focused message at this particular event by carrying signs pertinent to the occasion. Go to the corner of Burton Mesa Rd. and Constellation Rd. just north of Lompoc on Hwy 1.

Sunday March: The march from Vandenberg Village to the main gate of Vandenberg AFB commemorating the marches of 25 years ago, is between 2.5 and 3 miles. There will be transportation available to the main gate for those who feel they can’t make the trek or for those who begin but feel they can’t finish. There will be transportation back from the main gate to Vandenberg Village for all after the event. It is a one-way walk. Bring your own food and water; we are trying to stay away from throwaway plastic bottles.

Sunday CD Action at Vandenberg Main Gate: Those willing to participate in an act of Civil Disobedience at the main gate by crossing the green line, need to let organizers know ahead of time. There will be non-violent CD training the day before and follow-up and support for anyone arrested. While nothing is ever certain, past actions such as these have resulted in anywhere from \$1,000.00 fine and three years probation to 6 months in prison. We are not encouraging anyone to participate in CD unless they have advised us ahead of time and have participated in the non-violent CD workshop the day before.
